

CATHAY PACIFIC GROUP FACT SHEET

The Hong Kong-based Cathay Pacific Group offers scheduled passenger and cargo services to over 200 destinations in Asia, North America, Australia, Europe and Africa, using a fleet of close to 200 aircraft. There are three airlines in the Cathay Pacific Group:

- Cathay Pacific, an international network airline.
- Cathay Dragon, a wholly owned subsidiary of Cathay Pacific which focuses on providing services to destinations across Asia, including more than 20 cities in mainland China.
- AHK Air Hong Kong, an all-cargo carrier operating regional express freight services that Cathay Pacific is in the process of making into a wholly owned subsidiary.

Cathay Pacific is a member of the Swire group and is a public company listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange.

Cathay Pacific is a founder member of the **oneworld** global alliance and Cathay Dragon is an affiliate member.
